#### PONCA TRIBE OF NEBRASKA TRIBAL COUNCIL

<b>RESOLUTION 24</b>	-

WHEREAS: The Ponca Tribe of Nebraska is a federally recognized Indian Tribe (P.L. 101-484) whose business affairs are conducted by the Ponca Tribal Council as defined in the Constitution approved July 22, 1994 by the Acting Deputy Commissioner of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to the Constitution of the Ponca Tribe of Nebraska, the Ponca Tribal Council exercises legislative powers to enact and promulgate resolutions and ordinances subject to all express restrictions upon such powers contained in the constitution; and

WHEREAS: The Tribe has the authority to submit an application on behalf of the Native American individuals in the Tribe and to administer programs and activities under this program; and

WHEREAS: The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Health Resources and Services Administration provide health care to people who are geographically isolated, economically or medically vulnerable; and

WHEREAS: The Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), Center for Substance Abuse Treatment (CSAT) is accepting applications for the fiscal year 2024 for the Screening, Brief Intervention and Referral to Treatment (SBIRT) program. The purpose of this program is to implement the screening, brief intervention, and referral to treatment public health model for children, adolescents, and/or adults in primary care and community health settings (e.g., health centers, hospital systems, health maintenance organizations (HMOs), preferred-provider organizations (PPOs) health plans, Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHC), behavioral health centers, pediatric health care providers, children's hospitals) and schools with a focus on screening for underage drinking, opioid use, and other substance use. Recipients will be expected to deliver early intervention for individuals with risky alcohol and drug use, as well as the timely referral to more intensive treatment for those who have substance use disorders. With this program, SAMHSA aims to reduce risky alcohol and other drug use and reduce the negative physical and behavioral health consequences of this use.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Ponca Health Services is authorized to partner with U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration on the SBIRT (Screening, Brief Intervention, and Referral to Treatment) grant.
