Indoor Air Quality Assessments (IAQA) are scheduled on a 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> served bases. Initial IAQAs can take up to 3 hours to complete. We require an individual to be present in the home that is over the age of 19 while the IAQA is taking place. A follow up assessment (by visit, phone, or email) will take place no later than 3 month after the initial IAQA is completed. This is to determine if the indoor air quality has improved or not.

A major part of IAQA is radon testing. Radon testing takes 48 hrs +/- 2 hrs for the initial short term test. Based on radon sampling guidelines, homes must maintain closed conditions 12 hrs prior to testing and throughout the testing period. This includes: all windows, vents leading to the outside and external door must be closed (except for normal entry and exit) and most indoor/outdoor air exchange systems should be turned off (i.e. attic fans, whole house fans, window fans). Failure to so will result in an invalid test result and the radon test will have to be redone. Instructions and reminders will be mailed out before the IAQA start to give adequate time to comply with closed house conditions.
